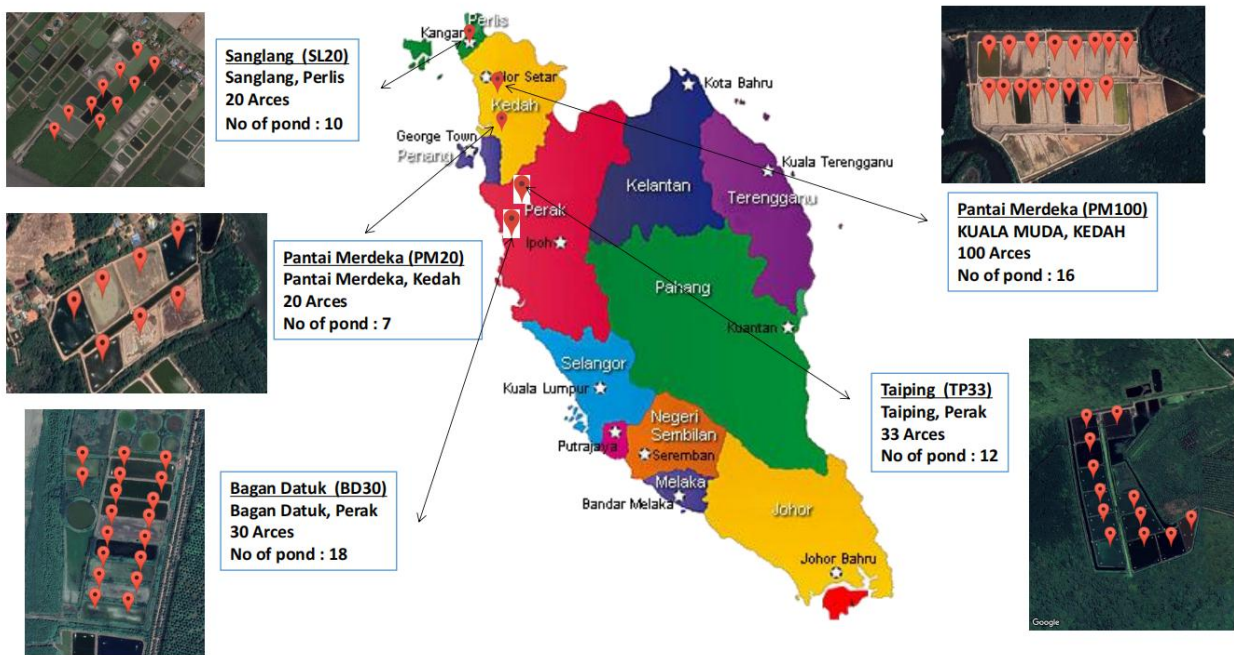

SANGLANG POND

Electricity load has always been a great challenge in prawn farming, we rely on paddlewheel to generate dissolved oxygen for the prawns at night.

We encountered load problem at our Sanglang farm, limiting our production to only **60%** of our capacity.

Thanks to the seamless corporation between our operation team and M&E Consultants, we are able to overcome this challenge and increase our load to max out our capacity.
